Are you pregnant?

Do not wait until the baby comes to get health insurance! Apply today with MNsure and you could receive financial assistance for prenatal care, delivery, and your new baby.

- You could be eligible for Medical Assistance even if you already have employer insurance
- You could be eligible for Medical Assistance even if you are currently receiving prenatal care at IHS
- Report your pregnancy as soon as possible!
- Medical Assistance past coverage can only go back 3 months
- Baby is not automatically covered by your insurance you
 must call to report the birth and request coverage for baby

WHEN TO UPDATE YOUR CASE:

Changes in Income:

Start a new job
Stop working
Permanent change in hours or
wage

Start or stop unemployment Start Social Security Disability Receive an inheritance or other one-time income that is reported on your tax return

Change in address:

Report your address so you get your notices!

Other changes:

Get married or divorced
Become pregnant
Have a baby
Become certified disabled
Become incarcerated
Any other change that might
affect your household size

Enrolling in health insurance through MNsure BEFORE you need services opens many options to you!

Many non-IHS providers will not schedule an appointment without active insurance; all MNsure programs qualify as health insurance.

You may be able to access more specialists.

You could be eligible for low or no cost insurance through MNsure.

COVID-19 EMERGENCY RENTAL ASSISTANCE

WHAT IS THIS PROGRAM?

The new program is called COVID-19 Emergency Rental Assistance and it will help eligible renters with overdue rent since March 2020, up to three months of upcoming rent at a time, and related utility payments. The program will be open for applications in a matter of weeks, with an anticipated launch in late March.



TELL ME WHO CAN APPLY!

Eligible renters will include households that earned 80% or less of area median income in 2020 or in the most recent month. With permission and cooperation from their renters Landlords will be able to apply on behalf of their eligible tenants.
